

GUADALAJARA CONSTRUYE 8 / FILMS IN PROGRESS

Call for entries for film projects in postproduction.

The Guadalajara International Film Festival announces the opening to apply for Guadalajara Construye 8 / Films in Progress; event which seeks to contribute to the conclusion of feature films and documentaries in their final postproduction stage. The event will take place on March 25th and 26th 2014 in Guadalajara, Jalisco, México.

Six films (fiction and documentary) in postproduction stage searching for funding to conclude them, will be screened for film industry professionals: producers, distributors, sales agents, and festival representatives with the possibility of helping these projects to finish and eventually be released.

- 1- All selected projects will have:
 - a) Showing of the film in the Industry screening room of FICG29.
 - b) The inclusion of project's information in the Guadalajara Construye 8 / Films in Progress catalogue.
 - c) Lodging for 3 nights in Guadalajara (One double room per project from the 24th to the 27th of March 2014, breakfast included).
 - d) Two Industry accreditation badges for representatives of each project.
- 2- The participation is free of charge. Travel and food expenses are responsibility of the representatives of the project.
- 3- The call for entries will remain open from September 3rd until December 13th, 2013.
- 4- Films registered in this section in prior editions will not be received.
- 5- Films with at least one first cut of a minimum of 70 mins. and a maximum of 140 mins. (Unless the estimated duration is longer)
- 6- The Organizing Committee has the right to include projects by direct invitation.
- 7- The results for the participating projects will be published in the beginning of February 2014. These results will be unappealable.
- 8- The selected projects must confirm their assistance to the event before February 13, 2014, otherwise their participation will be automatically cancelled and a runner up will be selected.



- 9- Once the film is selected, a copy in Blu-ray or a digital file(.mov) coded in Apple ProRes must be in Guadalajara by March 2014 (either sent to our offices or brought by the representatives of the project) In any case, the file must be in stereo sound and subtitled in English if the original language is Spanish and vice versa.

MANDATORY REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

1.- Fill in the electronic registration form found in the following link: <http://ficg.mx/gdlconstruye> before December 13th, 2013.

If a project is selected this will be the information published in both Industry and Guadalajara Construye Catalogues.

2.- Upload the most recent cut of the film (subtitled in Spanish or English depending of the original language) in a link and password.
